Pastor's Corner

Parish and School Updates

Beloved Parishioners,

I share with you some updates from the school and parish community. Beginning with the school, I am excited to share that the school growth has been very amazing. At the close of the last school academic year, the school population was 108 students. As of today, the current school population is 130 students. The school serves up to 7th grade and there are hopes of expanding as the need arises. There were an additional two classrooms for the 7th and 8th grades that were created from the existing school building and Holy Family Parish Hall. The grant from the Yass foundation was able to help us take care of the cost of the renovation.

Last Wednesday and Thursday, Maricela Campa, who is the program manager of the Mental Health Ministry of the Diocese, was in our parish to train some parishioners and members of the staff on the mental health ministry. Mental health ministry is an area our Bishop is very much concerned about as it is a ministry that has not been explored in the past. The two days training was well received by all those who attended, and the training testified to the need of the ministry and what it would achieve for the community.

On Saturday, August 19, 2023, the Planning Committee met to finalize year one goals of the Five-Year Plan. There were different committees to look at various aspects of the life of the parish to see how to bring fresh insight to it. Thus, members were put in charge of implementing the goals in the areas of Worship, Education, Outreach, Physical Facilities, Finance, and Human Resources.

On the committee for Worship, the goals are to focus on the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist with educational and retreat opportunities as well as the continuation of Eucharistic Adoration. The committee will equally see how a particular virtue would be introduced parish-wide in conjunction with the school to help us to practice virtues in our daily

lives. There is a concern to reach out to many people who work and cannot get to Masses on Sundays in the mornings. To address this problem, a new Mass time will be added on Sundays at 5:00 pm starting November 5th. This will replace the 5:45 pm Saturday Mass and will be an outreach to those who work weekends, young adults, many people who traveled out of town and returning to town to attend Mass and families who may prefer to attend at that time.

The Outreach committee is assigned to work on two community service projects per year. This will be developed in such a way that everyone is included: the children, youth, young adults, and elderly can be involved. The Physical Facilities committee has plans for preventive maintenance and budgeting for replacement and repair of our physical facilities. Some minor repairs are already taking place and while the rest like the parking lots, church ceiling and church painting will come when the funds are available. Many of our goals require funding and this continues to be a challenge for us all. Our Finance Council has a balanced budget for this year, and this has not happened for many years. The Finance Council is exploring more ways to bring in funds, including tithing. When the aspect of tithing is finalized, it will be communicated to the entire parish for everyone to participate. A new Building Campaign for the new school building and parish office needs to begin to continue to meet our needs.

My beloved parishioners, I remain most grateful to you all for your prayers, support, and good will. There is a need for prayers for these exciting goals to be realized as we wish to hit the ground running. It will be a continuous process of which we will keep you informed. Please pray for the success of our Parish in all its ministries. Any insight, suggestions, or contributions to achieve any of these goals will be welcomed.

Theme: Who is Jesus for You

21st Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A, August 27, 2023

1st Reading Isaiah 22:19-23, 2nd Reading Romans 11:33-36, Gospel Matthew 16:13-20

The first reading from the book of Isaiah paints a picture of what was going on towards the end of Isaiah's prophecy. Thus says the Lord to Shebna, master of the palace, "I will thrust you from your office and pull you down from your station." Shebna was meant to be a steward in the royal palace but suddenly, he began to see himself as a king forgetting his position as a steward. In his arrogant behavior God speaks through Isaiah that he would pull him down from his office and get Eliakim to take over whom he will elevate to be a father to many inhabitants of Jerusalem and to the house of Judah. There are times when many people forget that they are mere servants or instruments in God's hands. Some even tend to arrogate themselves to the position of God. Many others forget that without God all their accomplishments in life would not have been possible. The message of Isaiah in today's first reading calls for true humility recognizing our position as God's children.

In the second reading, Paul praises God for His wisdom and knowledge. That's why he says, "For from him and through him and for him are all things. To him be glory forever." We need to constantly give eternal praise to God in our lives every day. Praising God is a way we appreciate our dependence on God. God does not need our praises but by praising Him we acknowledge Him as our God in whom every existence and life proceeds from.

In the gospel, Jesus questions His disciples about His identity. He said to them "who do you say that I am?" They gave different answers of what people said He was, but He asks a direct question to them as to what His identity is. Peter, led by the Holy Spirit reveals the identity of Jesus and, Jesus confirms that it was the Holy Spirit who revealed the answer to him. Jesus makes Peter the head of His church and gives a profound promise that He will be with the church and that the power of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. From that moment, Peter became the Rock on whose leadership the church is built. God's church is not a human establishment, but a divine institution led by humans who are mortals. The church has encountered many turbulent challenges in the past and still faces attacks from all fronts till date, but as a divine establishment the Holy Spirit is still guiding the church. The promise of Jesus to be with the church till the end of time is still effective till date.

Our prayer is that God's Holy Spirit continues to abide in the church that the leaders who are mere mortals listen to the Holy Spirit who has promised to continue to be with the church till the end of time.

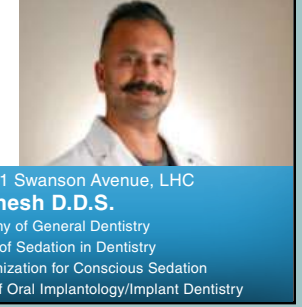
