We have also included information about how to apply for scholarships: please complete an online application for FAIR- Financial Aid Independent Review, IBE- Institute for Better Education and ATC – Arizona Tuition Connection. CEA – Catholic Education Arizona's application is done by completing the FAIR application. This current school year 2020-2021 we had 97% of our students participate in at least one of the 3 scholarships available to them. In 2021-2022 we look forward to 100% participation.

It is of utmost importance that all school registration packets and scholarship applications are completed as soon as possible. Please drop off completed applications to the school or Parish office. With the child's birth certificate, baptismal certificate and immunization records to copy.

It is my prayer that as a staff and school family, we will be receptive to all the graces lavishly bestowed by the Holy Spirit to empower us for our mission. Lastly, we entrust our work and mission into the hands of the one whose fiat changed the world!
